How To Prepare For The Service



LIVING ROOM, BEDROOMS, ETC

- Arrange to have your pet(s) treated professionally for fleas before treatment.
- Pet bedding must be laundered on high heat.
- Vacuum all carpet, rugs, and furniture. Discard the vacuum bag immediately. Consider steam-cleaning heavily soiled areas.
- Move ALL items 6 inches away from walls.
- Remove all small items from the floor. This includes closets, under beds, & behind couches. Electronic equipment & heavy furniture may be left in place.

After The Treatment

To ensure treatment is effective follow these steps after your home is serviced.

- Ventilate your unit & replace all contents.
- **DO NOT** wash baseboards or floor surfaces for 3 weeks.
- **AVOID** touching treated areas.
- **DO NOT** use over-the-counter pest control chemicals.
- Vacuum daily for the first week after service. Fleas sense vibrations & will emerge to treated areas.
- **DO NOT** steam clean carpet for 30 days.
- You may experience activity for 3 weeks after service. If activity continues contact your building manager or owner to schedule a follow-up.

Reminder

ALL persons & pets must leave for 4-6 hours after treatment.

Pregnant, nursing women, children under 2 years, or those with allergies must vacate for 8-12 hours.

SERVICE WILL NOT BE PERFORMED WITHOUT PROPER PREPARATION.

Fish tanks must be covered with filters turned off. Persons with health conditions should consult a doctor for re-entry time.

What You Can Expect From The Treatment

Your technician will use several strategies to control the fleas.

Treatment areas consist of the room's carpet, baseboards, and pet resting areas.
