PREPARATION FORM

To help our team give you the best service, please complete the preparations listed below before we arrive. These steps are important to ensure that your Technician can carry out a safe and effective treatment.



How To Prepare For The Service

KITCHEN



- Empty all items from cabinets and drawers below the sink, including dishes, pots, and food
- ALL surfaces MUST be clean (ie. dishes, fridge, stove, microwave & toaster).
- Make sure all surfaces, such as dishes, fridge, stove, microwave, and toaster, are thoroughly cleaned.
- Check your dried food for bugs. If you find any, throw away the infested ones. Keep the bug-free food in sealed plastic containers.
- Tell the Technician if you find bugs in your dried food or pet food.

After The Treatment

- If you have fish tanks, cover them and turn off air filters. This helps keep the treatment effective.
- Stay out of treatment area 4 hours after the treatment begins.
- Keep all your food in tightly sealed containers, clean up spills right away, and take out the trash regularly.
- **DO NOT** use over-the-counter products to treat. Your Technician will follow-up to check if your issue is resolved.

Reminder

If you have health issues, ask your doctor when it's safe to go back home.

SERVICE WILL NOT BE PERFORMED WITHOUT PROPER PREPARATION.

Please be patient, it may require several visits or 2 to 3 weeks to control the infestation.

What You Can Expect From The Treatment

Your Technician will use sprays and insecticides where bugs are active.

Your Technician will implement a program using traps & glue boards where necessary. All treatments will be made with your safety in mind.
