How To Prepare For The Service



EXTERIOR

Move all planters & furniture 6" from the walls.

**DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MOVE
LARGE FURNITURE**



KITCHEN

Empty bottom cupboards and bottom of closets where ants were sighted.

**DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MOVE
LARGE FURNITURE**



BEDROOMS, LIVING, GARAGE & ETC

Move all furniture 6" away from walls.
Clear all closet floors.

**DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MOVE
LARGE FURNITURE**

After The Treatment

Bait treatment will remain effective if the following steps are followed:

- DO NOT self-treat or use other chemicals near the treatment area

- Remove all food sources from the floor
- Keep food in tightly sealed containers
- Clean spills regularly
- Take out the trash regularly

Reminder

It may be necessary for you and your pets to leave your home for 4 hours once the treatment begins. Consult your technician.

Consult your family physician for concerns regarding re-entry time. Upon re-entry open windows for 20 minutes in treated rooms.

What You Can Expect From The Treatment

Your technician completes an inspection & uses a variety of methods to control the pavement ants.

Liquid sprays, bait stations, and/or dust may be used. All treatments are performed with your safety in mind.

SERVICE WILL NOT BE PERFORMED WITHOUT PROPER PREPARATION.

DO NOT MOVE OR TAMPER WITH BAIT STATIONS.
